WESTWORLD OF SCOTTSDALE

16601 North Pima Road

Please note that WestWorld has 3 entrances. The Main entrance is located just north of Frank Lloyd Wright on the north bound access road of SR-101. The north entrance is at 94th Street and Bell Road. The McDowell Mountain Ranch entrance is only open during show season and special events. Call in advance if you have any questions.

NORTH (Flagstaff):

I-17 South to SR-101 Loop — Eastbound into Scottsdale. Take the Pima/Princess exit. Make a left at Bell Road (second light) Continue east on Bell Road. Turn right on 94 Street. Travel south to the WestWorld entrance.

SOUTH (Tucson):

I-10 to US-60 (Superstition Freeway), US-60 East to SR-101 Loop, SR-101 North to Frank Lloyd Wright Blvd. Exit at Frank Lloyd Wright Blvd., move to far right lane. Continue straight, crossing the Frank Lloyd Wright intersection. WestWorld entrance is ½ block north on the right at large horse statue.

EAST (Globe):

US-60 (Superstition Freeway) West to SR-101 Loop, SR-101 North to Frank Lloyd Wright Blvd. exit. Exit at Frank Lloyd Wright Blvd.. Move to far right lane. Continue straight, crossing the Frank Lloyd Wright intersection; move to right lane. The entranceis ½ block from intersection. Turn right at largehorse statue.

WEST (California):

I-10 East to SR-101 North (near Tolleson). Remain on SR 101 into Scottsdale. Take the Pima/Princess exit. Make a left at Bell Road (second light) Continue east on Bell Road. Turn right on 94 Street. Travel south to the WestWorld entrance.

Navigating the parking lots will be difficult, especially during the Auction Days, and it can take up 30 minutes to get into a spot and walk to Dispatch. Plan accordingly please DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From the NORTH: Exit BELL ROAD and head EAST to 98th Street. Turn SOUTH and park in LOT 5 (on your right)

From the SOUTH: Exit FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT and turn EAST to THOMPSON PEAK. Turn NORTH to MCDOWELL RANCH ROAD Turn WEST on MCDOWELL RANCH ROAD and park in LOT 5 (on your right)



Uniform Standards:

Due the high profile nature of the event, an ALTERNATE uniform is used. Guards may wear their standard Polo on all overnight shifts, and during the day **until MONDAY**, **January 17**th. At that point, the onsite supervisor will issue Barrett-Jackson Polo's. Overnight Security may continue to wear their regular uniform. Barrett Polo's will be issued per shift, and are not available to be signed out under any circumstances. Solid white or black long sleeve shirts are highly suggested to wear in layers under the Barrett Jackson polo, as it does get cold.







BDU style pants are **NOT** to be worn after January 17th. Simple Plain black slacks are the only acceptable pants. (Overnight guards are the exception, they may wear the standard style of pants.) Long underwear are highly suggested to wear underneath.

Cold weather Gear: Guards are strongly encouraged to dress in WARM layers, bring gloves or mittens, and a winter hat. Black "beanies" are acceptable, (without any visible logos) Experience has taught us the usefulness of Hot Hands and Feet warming packets. (Available at Walmarts, Walgreens, Sam's Club and Costco, and probably other places.)









Shoes: 99.8% of the event is standing a post or constantly walking. Baby your feet a bit. Comfortable, good fitting, supportive shoes make a huge difference. I also suggest investing in a pair of comfort insoles, and soaking your feet in Epsom Salts.

Food and Drink: There are a large number of food vendors onsite. And many are delicious. They are also *very* expensive and do not provide discounts to anyone. I will be bringing out a microwave that I will make available at Dispatch, and please remember to bring ample food and water, providing yourself with sustenance is a very important responsibility. There is a Safeway Grocery store about 5 minutes away from the Auction Site, on Thompson Peak Rd.

General Barrett Jackson Auction Information:

Barrett Jackson is an annual Collector Car Auction, with the Scottsdale Auction as the Flagship, and the recently added shows in Las Vegas, Orange County and Palm Beach. The Barrett-Jackson company was formed in 1971, and is still family operated. Over 1700 cars will cross the block this January. Every vehicle at Barrett will be auctioned. The Auction is a "no reserve" style, so however low or high the price of the car is when the gavel drops is what the car is sold for. To partake in the actually Auction, you have to be a registered Bidder, but the general public is more than welcome to observe the auctioning of the cars. The media coverage is extensive, including constant filming by the HistoryChannel- This auction has some of the most famous and rare cars in the world.
