This up coming weekend we have our bi-annual Tempe Festival of the Arts.


It is a signature event for the City of Tempe, the DTA, and TEAM.

25 W 5th Street, Tempe 85281 and Dispatch will open THURSDAY 3/30 at 3pm. (1500) prior to that shifts should report to specific duty locations and bring a shirt.

Driving Directions: MILL AVE IS CLOSED FROM UNIVERSITY TO 3RD

Located on Mill Avenue between 3rd Street and University Drive in Downtown Tempe

From the Southeast Valley: Take the Price Freeway 101 Loop north to the Red Mountain Freeway Loop 202. Head west on the 202 toward Phoenix. Exit at Rural Road and go left (south) to Rio Salado Parkway. Turn right (west) on Rio Salado parkway to Mill Avenue. — or — Take US-60 Superstition Freeway to Mill Avenue exit. Go north on Mill Avenue.

From the South Valley: Take I-10 west towards Phoenix. Exit at 143 Hohokam Expy, and take that to the University Exit. Go east (right) on University to Mill Avenue and make a left (north) on Mill Avenue.

From the North Valley: Take SR-51 to the Loop 202 Red Mountain Freeway. Go east on the 202. Exit at Priest Road and make a right (south) to Rio Salado Parkway. Make a left (east) on Rio Salado to Mill Avenue.

Parking Directions:

There are numerous garage and parking locations in the Downtown area. During the Festival weekend, there is no parking within the event perimeter, however there is ample along the perimeter. The US Airways and City Hall Garages are most conven-

iently located. Other parking locations are listed here along with a map to get you there.

Light Rail

The Light Rail stops just at the edge of the event and is the easiest way in and out of the event area. Park and Rides are valleywide; a listing can be found here with "how to" and trip planning information here
